C. Requests for Projects and Assistance – Guidelines

- Grumpies will not perform work for anyone who can afford to hire a professional unless extenuating circumstances exist, the pastors request it, or the Mission Board / Trustees request and fund the work. Sometime the request may be made simply because professionals will not take on low-paying jobs.
- Grumpies are not free labor to perform routine cleaning, yard maintenance, moving and packing, etc., for individuals not in extenuating circumstances.
- Grumpies will not charge for work but recipients of Grumpy assistance may make an unsolicited donation to PBUMC (preferably marked for the Grumpy fund).
- The Project Coordination Committee may disallow an assistance request if Grumpy time and talent are not available to safely accomplish a task in the timeframe requested.
- The Project Coordination Committee shall not accept or approve an assistance request that will put an individual, the GOM organization, or PBUMC in a liability situation. This may require some out-of-the-box considerations and consultations with PBUMC leadership.
- Grumpy repair and construction work is rated at the DIY level (better than most!) but will not be considered licensed contractor work that will require a County Building permit.
- Grumpies can do moderate electrical repairs, replace light fixtures, ceiling fans, outlets and switches, but **not** new wiring or make connections to an electrical circuit breaker panel that require a certified electrician.
- Grumpies can do moderate plumbing repairs, repair leaky faucets / toilets but **not** new plumbing that requires a certified plumber. Grumpies can assist with repair of immediate, small roof leaks, but not reroofing that requires a County permit.
- Requests for moving furniture / appliances and picking up furniture for the Redemption Store will be referred directly to the Store. The Store manager will determine if a pickup should be made and contact the Grumpy designee.
- Requests for structural repair or construction (ramps, fences, porch decks, etc.) will be vetted by the Project Coordination Committee and presented to a Grumpy meeting.
- Urgent requests for emergency repairs should be referred to a contractor if they cannot wait for assessment, Grumpy meeting discussion, and assignment.
