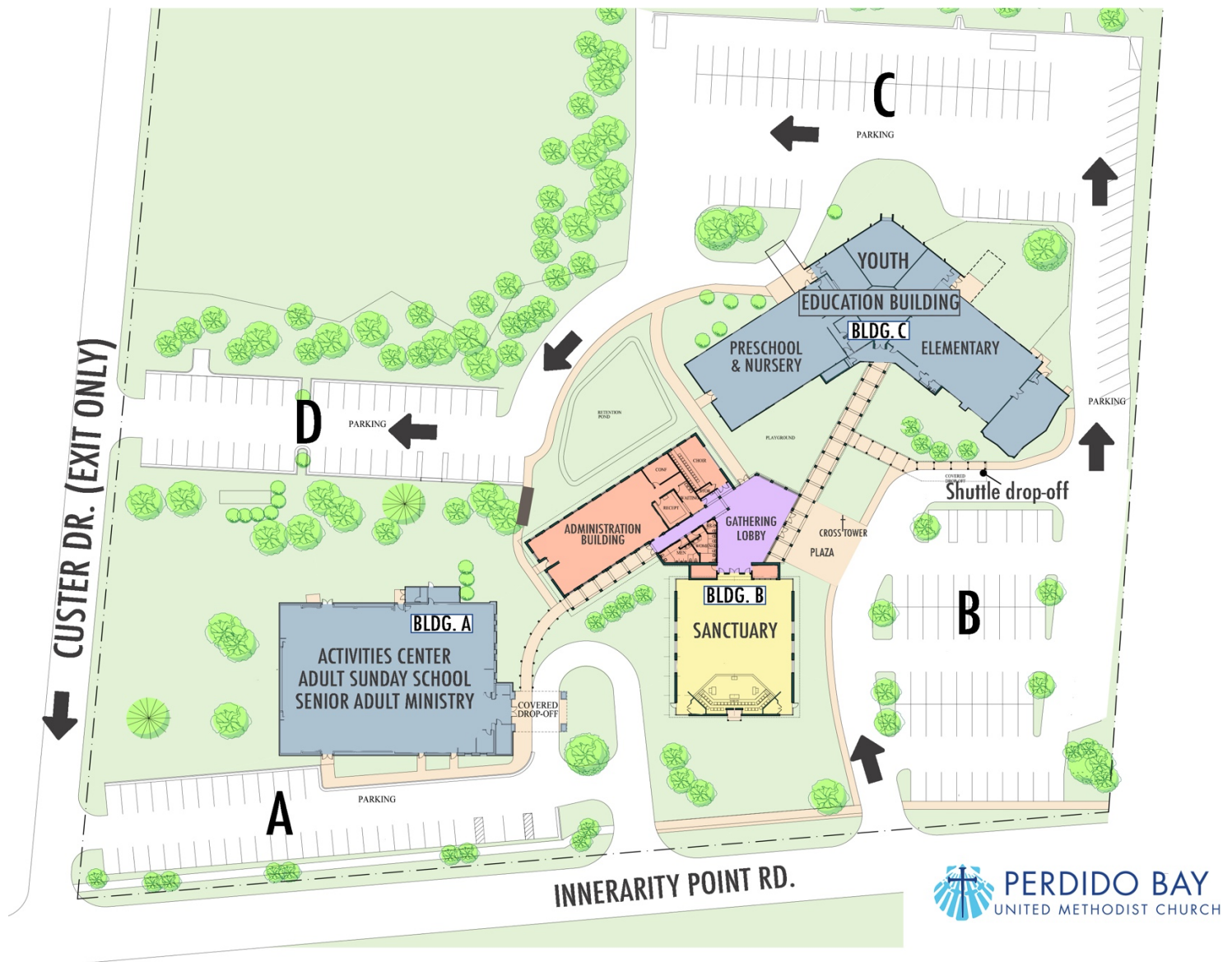

Traffic Flow

Please note the one-way traffic flow throughout the church campus. Each parking lot is marked A-D. There is a covered and wheelchair accessible drop-off area in Parking Lot B (to access Sanctuary, Church Office, Music Suite, and Education Building), as well as Parking Lot A (to access Activities Center).

Shuttle Service

A shuttle is available to transport you from parking lots A, C, and D to the covered drop off area near the entrance to the Sanctuary and Education Buildings. Please look for the pick-up area in each of the parking lots. The shuttle runs before and after each worship service as well as Wednesday evenings and other events.

Sunday Morning Worship
